This people group is very much open to the Gospel and truly hungry to hear. We will be traveling each day to a village somewhere around 10,000 to 14,000 feet above sea level. The Quechua are a hardworking people and very much family oriented. They live quite lives and have always been very humble about our visiting. They are also shy people and it often takes a little while being there to get them to open up. I personally believe that this is because they have always been a repressed people and have lived and been treated like Third class citizens in their own land for over 2000 years.

Please pray for safe traveling for the 23 team members; for good health while we are there; for boldness to share the Gospel and that Satan would not have His way in any respect.
