There will be 19 men from various states gathering together and leaving from Texas on November 3rd and returning on November 10th. Please be in prayer for the team as we will be traveling as high as 12,000 to 14,000 feet above sea level. This is a normal day in the life of a Quechua Indian, but for a young American man and a few old guys, this trip will prove to be taxing. I'm very sure.

We are also looking forward to working with the Ecuadorian military as we have been for the past few years.

Through a great deal of prayer and how our Lord Jesus has proved Himself faithful in the past, I expect to be blessed by witnessing a great harvest as these people are very hungry for the Gospel. So, please be on your knees in prayer, and when we return, I will be ready to give you a report of how great our Lord is.
